Post Production Item	Current Method	Solution
Empty cartons/boxes	Discarded at random workspaces	Overhead “takeaway” belt conveyor with high-sides and input points for refuse. Carries to a central location for recycling
	Employees hired to “patrol” and pick up discarded boxes	
	Various dumpsters located within facility	
Strapping or banding	Put into drums or dumpsters at work stations	Drums or bins staged on low-level takeaway conveyors. Accumulated to release once full or picked up for recycling.
	Thrown on floor for maintenance to clean up	
	Discarded randomly with regular trash	
Excess fill or dunnage	Swept up or out	Collected and repacked (if desired) with floor to floor conveyor for reuse
	Hand picked and reused by packing employees
