Jonesboro plant enlarged to over 300,000 sq. ft.

Western Stockyard in California opens.

Hytrol undergoes extensive expansion, bringing Jonesboro plant to over 420,000 sq. ft.

Construction completed on new 13,500 sq. ft. Technology Center.

New 18,000 sq. ft. powder paint system put into production.
