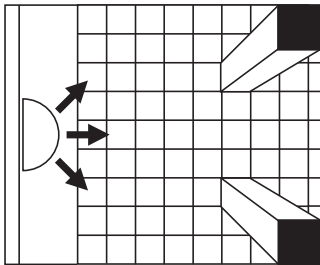


180° Mirrored Half Domes



Half Domes are used for a “T” intersection of a building. Smaller units such as the 18” and 26” are commonly used in hospitals, offices and retail applications. The view is similar to the full dome, but can be mounted to the ceiling or on a wall at the end of an aisle or hallway.



For industrial use larger domes can be mounted on the end of aisles at a lower level than most full domes. These half domes would be mounted at the end of an aisle where a forklift operator can see in both directions without needing to look towards the ceiling.

The view distance ratio is about 1 foot of viewing distance to each inch of the diameter of the dome.
